Swim school looks for land

A NEW pool is desperately needed in the north-east to cater for soaring demand for swimming lessons, SA's biggest swim school says.

State Swim wants to expand into the north-east but is being hindered by a lack of available sites.

Land at Glynde, Campbelltown, Athelstone and Magill has been looked at by State Swim as possible sites for a new centre.

Director **Paul Mason** examined six properties in the north-east in the past year, including industrial sites off Glynburn Rd, Glynde, but all were deemed unsuitable due to a lack of space for carparks.

State Swim's nearest centre, at Norwood, was almost at capacity.

Norwood and Payneham outdoor pools manager **Grant Watkins** said summer swimming classes were also at capacity.
